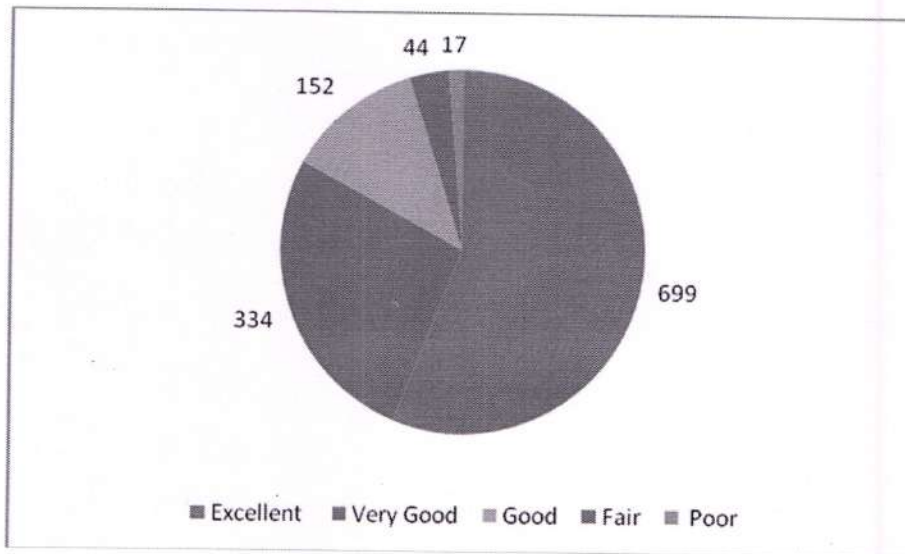

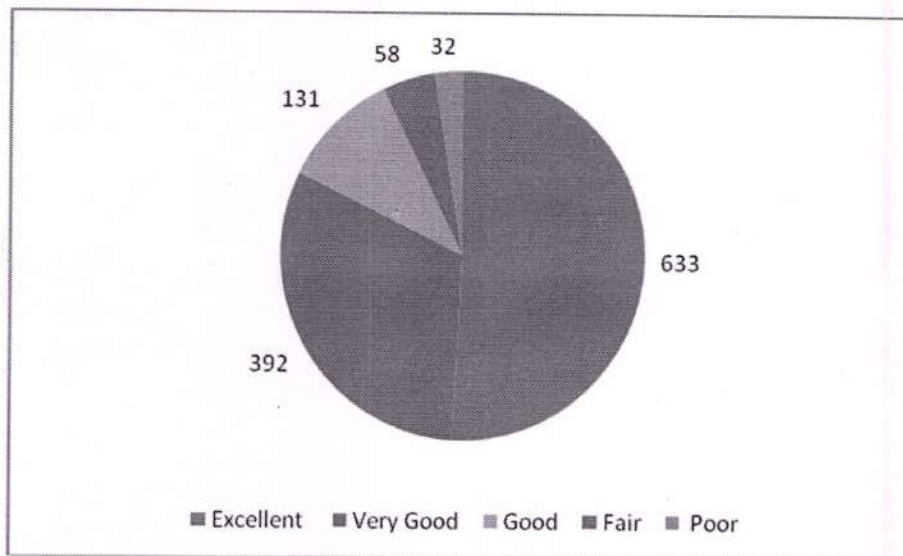

Overall academic response was found to be 83%.
